

Baldwin Handleset Measuring Guide

Backset Measurement

Backset is the horizontal distance from the door edge to the center of the cylinder or handle. Standard backsets are 2.375" and 2.75". Measure from the outside face of the door to the center of the bore hole.

Door Thickness

Baldwin handlesets accommodate door thickness between 1.375" and 1.75". Some high-security models support thicker doors up to 2". Verify your door thickness before specifying hardware to ensure proper operation.

Measurement	Standard Range	Method
Backset	2.375" / 2.75"	Edge to Center
Door Thickness	1.375" - 1.75"	Through Door
Hole Spacing	1" - 2.875"	Center to Center
Grip Size	6" - 8"	Overall Length

Grip Size Selection

Baldwin handle grip sizes range from 6" to 8" overall length. Larger grips (8") are standard for exterior doors, while smaller grips (6") suit interior applications. Consider accessibility and ergonomics when selecting grip size.
