S&G; UL Group Ratings Explained

UL 768 Lock Group Classifications

The UL Group Rating system classifies high-security locks by resistance to manipulation and forced entry. Higher groups indicate greater security but come with cost implications.

Group 2 - Standard Commercial

- Standard safes, filing cabinets, indoor vaults
- Resistance to picking, drilling, and basic manipulation techniques
- Insurance requirements: typically covers 80% of contents
- Cost-effective for general commercial applications

Group 1 - High Security

- Manipulation-resistant design with hardened components
- Insurance coverage: 90-95% of contents typical
- Required for jewelry stores, banks, high-value storage
- Recommended rekeying interval: 5 years

Group 1R - Manipulation Resistant

- Advanced electronic sensing prevents unauthorized manipulation
- Insurance coverage: up to 98-100% of contents
- Three-attempt lockout after failed entries
- Audit trail logging for compliance documentation
